Another great reason to purchase tickets...

- This event will help support the 1,000 children from Sedgwick County in Youthville’s care on a daily basis who have suffered abuse or neglect and can no longer live safely at home.
- 7,000 adults, children, and families participate in Youthville program and services annually, utilizing its counseling, foster care, adoption, case management, trauma therapy, or psychiatric residential treatment.
- An additional \$78 a month per child is needed to cover expenses including reintegration support, emergency and medical needs, therapeutic treatment, life skills & independent living and foster home support and training.
- An additional \$50 per person is needed to cover an hour of therapy, on average children who have been abused or neglected attend at least 13 sessions. Nearly 30,000 therapy session were conducted last year.
